- 2.3.1 10/1915/FUL Stockers Cottage** – Erection of conservatory. COMMENTS: Luppitt parish council have no objections to the proposal, however we would like to see stone cladding on the north west road elevation (oil tank side), as the hedge may not always be there to shield the view. RATIFIED.

**3 HIGHWAYS AND TRAFFIC**

- 3.1** Parish Highways programme – the five new grit bins have been installed and two bags of pure salt have been placed in each and they are also due to have DCC refills over winter, although it is not known when. It was discussed that Rawridge New Road and Shelf residents have also made requests, both are served by milk lorries and do carry local traffic. This was noted for future discussion. It was agreed that Cllr Sparks will laminate correct dosage notices and place these inside each bin.
- 3.2** Highways issues to report – following the meeting with DCC the lengthsman is trying to resolve issues, there is further work needed, mainly jetting. It was agreed to report that the clerk should ask again about the jetting drain at Pitt to Barn, new tarmac laid over the drain exit at Newmans & outside the Church gate drain which seems unconnected.  
Potholes – Shelf Lane there is still a pothole that was missed. There are signs left all over Luppitt from repairs made a month ago, warning of potholes, 15mph, diversion, men at work, please could SWH come and pick these up.  
Chairman asked for lengthsman issues to be noted for next meeting.
- 3.3** Laybys – Cllr Pulman has assessed all the laybys in the parish and noted five needing planings, in addition there are several gateways against the road used as passing places. These were listed and agreed. In addition the layby at Bridge by River Love before Langford needs improvement – to be added to list for A R Tucker when planings arrive. The road planings in the layby have been hauled away and we didn't receive the planings from Langford Bridge, clerk to request 30 tonnes to be dropped to the Gravel Pitt on Luppitt Common Road.
